




- Palazzo Salviati is a Renaissance building located in Rome, in via della Lungara. Its construction started in 1520, thanks to Filippo Adimari, a renowned and cultured prelate from Florence.
- In 1568, when the building was owned by Cardinal Giovanni Salviati, Giovanni Lippi, also known as Nanni di Baccio Bigio, was mandated to complete its works and enlarge its structure.
- From 1883 to 1943, it hosted the **Military College of Rome**, but it was not until 1933 that it gained its current architectural configuration.



 Since 1971, Palazzo Salviati has been home to the Centre for Higher Defence Studies (CASD).

Experiential modules

- Our training modules aim at enhancing Soft Skills, or cross-cutting competencies, such as self-awareness, teamwork, emotional intelligence and strategic thinking. These competencies are the essential requirements of future leaders, allowing them to anticipate change and tackle the challenges of rapidly changing current scenarios.
- Such soft skills require a new learning context, as the delivery of mere theoretical aspects is no longer enough. There is the need of an innovative approach, focused on the "action-reflection" pattern delivered in a specific teaching and learning setting, including outdoor sessions.
- This training format aims at developing and/or strengthening skills in terms of emotional self-awareness, self-management and interpersonal skills. The ultimate goal is to increase the individual and organizational well-being, in the framework of an overall personal growth improvement process.




